

Optimised approach

Pollution controls	Implement & treat waste and emissions
Cleaner production	Process optimisation — reduce resources; substitute with non-toxic & renewable resources
Eco efficiency	Environmental strategy & monitoring management
Lifecycle thinking	Extend environmental responsibility beyond production e.g. supply chain management
Closed loop production	Restructure production processes to minimise / eliminate virgin raw materials
Synergised approach	Create environmental partnerships



Critical success factors

Management & organisation	 Management structure to support process Capacity development & education Businesses but be involved from beginning Transition & planning must have bottom up support Need (evolving) long term strategy for effective decision making at each stage
Technology	 More than exchange of by-products / waste between companies Focus on resource recovery with plant focus on clean production
Resource based policy	- Need policy-level support / incentives
Cleaner production	- Must be viewed as complementary to overall strategy
Recognition	- Excellent management, systems and structures must be recognised




